Business Meeting
November 17, 2011

The TWFR Business meeting was called to order and declared an open meeting by Service Director Nancy Des Jardins at 6:35 pm.

The Treasurer and Secretary's minutes were read and approved.

Correspondence: We received a card and donation from Marge Pearce. We will be using it toward the trailer heater.

General announcements: WI DHS has adopted the National Education Standards and Scope of Practice. They have increased the EMS training for all branches...EMR, EMT and Paramedics. The presently licensed individuals are grandfathered in and will get the new additions at their next refresher class.

The revised Emergency Services Plan has been completed. We did receive a copy of the full revision and a strictly EMS shortened version from Dr. Martens at the EMS Association meeting last week. Both versions are available to pick up.

WEMSA Hot Sheets should be coming to each of us...if we do not receive them, please let Nancy DesJardins know.

Elections: Unanimous nominations for Service Director: Nancy Des Jardins; Member-at-Large: Kim Gartman; & Secretary: Ginger Aschebrock. We will be able to add to the nominations at the December meeting prior to voting.

Jodi Conroy will be handling the Salvation Army bell ringing and the Adopt-a-Family program through the Salvation Army. Kim Gartman will be purchasing the family gifts. December 17th is the date for the bell ringing at the south side Piggly Wiggly from 5-7 with a potential for Pizza Party to follow.

Kim Gartman will be setting up the Christmas Dinner for a January date due to the hectic holiday season. She will let us know at the next meeting when and what time at Majerle's.

The AEDs need to be updated and we are presently waiting for an answer re: the program and how it needs to be completed.

Training: Tom Sonntag has resigned as Training Officer...it will now be handled as a Committee by the Board beginning with his resignation date. Sean Hurley has also resigned effective December 1st.

Fire Rehab: Dan Hartmann reported that we have the wrong tripod light. All the parts are correct except for the light...they sent a 12 volt instead of a 120 and it does not work with the current set-up. They will be sending us a replacement light. He also reported on the presentation to the town board re: the MABAS request. Three members were in favor and one had some questions and one was a "no comment". The main question was if we can leave a MABAS call, if we have a call in the Town. Further discussion will be tabled until the next meeting, till we can get further info re: the questions from the Board. We displayed the trailer at the EMS association meeting last week. We also attended the EMS Council meeting last night to display the trailer. We had a very good response from both trips. He will be talking to Cheryl Rostollan about getting on the next town board meeting for approval. We cannot bill for the supplies used on MABAS but, we can decline to go, if we have no one available to take the trailer and stay with the trailer. If the call is out of the town, then the on-call people must stay in the town. If BRFD gets a call then we have to notify the incident commander. The Incident Commander would then have to release us and determine if he wants to call in someone else per Steve Steinhardt.
